## THE FINISHED CHART

THE

Note the direction of the signs through the chart.

MARS 5

In this chart, Mars had just risen, i.e. crossed the Eastern horizon, and Mercury was about to rise.

ASCENDING DEGREE


The Ascending degree always forms the cusp of the first house.

THE SUN

For this location, the Sun would be rising in roughly I hour 20 minutes. It is below the horizon with all the other planets except Meptune, which was just about setting in the west.

IMUM COELI

Many astrologers mark the Imum Coeli (IC), the opposite point to the MC on their birth charts. As it is not easy to see, it is not really necessary, but this sensitive part of the chart must not be forgotten.



If you draw a little arrow here, it will remind you of the precise position of the MC.

These are the houses of the birth chart. Note their direction from I to I2 through the chart.

This double line represents the horizon. It is useful to mark it on your chart in blue and green, representing the meeting of the earth (green, below) and sky (blue, above).

These are the cusps of the signs & houses: the points at which they change from one sign to the next.
